Primary format: Month-Day-Year

## Three ways to write the same date

Month-Day-Year

**I · I · MDCXC**

January 01, 1690

Day-Month-Year

**I · I · MDCXC**

01 January 1690

Year-Month-Day

**MDCXC · I · I**

1690 January 01

## How the date is formed

MONTH

January

1 = I

DAY

**01**

1 = I

YEAR

**1690**

1690 = MDCXC
