## Three ways to write the same date

Month-Day-Year

**I · IV · MDCLXXXVI**

January 04, 1686

Day-Month-Year

**IV · I · MDCLXXXVI**

04 January 1686

Year-Month-Day

**MDCLXXXVI · I · IV**

1686 January 04

## How the date is formed

MONTH

January

1 = I

DAY

04

4 = IV

YEAR

1686

1686 = MDCLXXXVI
