## Three ways to write the same date

Month-Day-Year

**I · IX · MCDLXXXII**

January 09, 1482

Day-Month-Year

**IX · I · MCDLXXXII**

09 January 1482

Year-Month-Day

**MCDLXXXII · I · IX**

1482 January 09

## How the date is formed

MONTH

January

1 = I

DAY

09

9 = IX

YEAR

1482

1482 = MCDLXXXII
